What is Skills Connect?

Skills Connect offers free training courses to all adults across West Yorkshire. Focusing on key sectors such as digital, construction and the green economy, health and graduates. It is delivered by the West Yorkshire Combined Authority in partnership with the Leeds City Region Enterprise Partnership (LEP) under the LEP's FutureGoals brand.

Skills Connect is funded by the West Yorkshire Combined Authority through Gainshare, which was secured by the Leaders of West Yorkshire Councils and the Combined Authority through the West Yorkshire Devolution Deal.





What types of courses will we offer?

Initial courses will concentrate on in-demand skills and job vacancies in West Yorkshire. These include digital, construction, engineering and healthcare sectors. There will also be courses available to address the need for people to fill green jobs and in the emerging green technology sector.

Digital courses will support entry into some of the most in demand roles currently available in our region, e.g., Cyber Security, Digital Marketing and Data Analytics.

A Site Operative training course will offer a genuine entry route into the construction sector with many opportunities to progress further.

There will be an Introduction to Adult Social Care offer to help those who are interested in developing their skills to enter this rewarding sector. The Combined Authority is working closely with the NHS to offer real insights and training into many of the job roles and vacancies available; many of which are not clinical or client-facing.





Completing a Skills Connect course

Employers are at the heart of the programme, and training courses have been designed to align to their skills needs and current vacancies. Course content is developed alongside employers so individuals can be sure the training is fit for purpose and offers the best opportunity for progression into work or within a current job role.

There will be opportunities to learn directly from industry and business professionals with guaranteed post-training interviews available in some sector specific courses giving a direct line of sight to vacancies.

All courses will include expert careers information advice and guidance (CIAG) so participants have the information required to enter employment or change role and enhance their career.







Aim of the marketing activity

The aim of the marketing is to promote the Skills Connect training courses to adults across West Yorkshire. Our target is for 4780 adults to complete a Skills Connect course between now and the 31st March 2023.

Target audiences include: the unemployed, individuals at risk of redundancy, career changers, employed individuals looking to upskill, women returning to work, diverse ethnic groups, disadvantaged or underrepresented groups, graduates, underrepresented cohorts in particular sectors i.e., females in construction and the over 50's.
